

ANDY HALAZ
HEAD COACH
AND CAMP DIRECTOR

Halaz coached in the GLVC as an assistant at Rockhurst University — where he earned his bachelor's degree from in 2008 — for four seasons. During those four seasons, the Hawks posted a record of 103-34 and reached the NCAA Division II Tournament in each of those years.

Halaz left Rockhurst following the 2007 season to become the assistant coach and director of volleyball operations at Saint Louis University. While he was there, the Billikens made the NCAA Tournament field. The Billikens had a record of 53-13 over those two seasons. Halaz would return to the Saint Louis program in 2015 as a volunteer assistant coach.

Following the 2009 season, Halaz moved on to Georgetown University in Washington, D.C., where he was the lead court trainer for the Hoyas and also coordinated the team's summer camps, fundraisers and service projects. In addition, he was the Big East Conference's assistant coach liaison to the American Volleyball Coaches Association.

While at Georgetown, Halaz also became a program coach with USA Volleyball, where he coached A1 and A2 teams at camps and the High Performance Championships. He also coached the Youth National Team Prospects winter training program in 2015.

Since 2014, Halaz has served as the director of marketing and the outdoor director for High Performance-STL Volleyball Club in St. Louis, where he has coached one of the club's top teams and has organized the outdoor training program.

ADVANCED SPECIALITY CAMP

July 12–13, 2018 (Thursday–Friday) | Grades 8–12 and College Varsity Level | High Level Club | College Prep

- Resident (overnight, all meals) \$225
- Commuter (no meals) \$175

Advanced Specialty Camp is for 8–12 grade and college girls with varsity, high level club or collegiate experience. This will be a higher level camp than the General All-Skills camp and is designed for the advanced player who wants to progress to the next level. This camp will provide specific instruction and drills for technical development of all volleyball skills. Campers are instructed by specific positions: outside and right side hitters, middle hitters, setters and libero/defensive specialists finishing with team play and development. General All-Skills camp is for incoming 1–8 grade girls of any experience level. The camp is designed to develop and/or increase the overall development of every player regardless of skill level. The General All-Skills camp will provide volleyball fundamentals through individual skill instruction, while also allowing campers to learn team concepts and compete in games and tournaments. Campers will be tested and combined with similar skill levels for drills and competitions. We will accept campers, including overnight campers, up until the start of camp, however there will be a \$10 price increase per camper for day-of registrations.
